HOW CAN I USE D.A.P.® ?

FOR AT HOME

Plug D.A.P. Diffuser into any AC outlet in the
room your dog stays most often, or where
the dog exhibits stressful reactions. If your
dog has run of the house, you may plug a
diffuser in another floor used by the dog.
Each diffuser lasts about 4 weeks. Refills
are available.

- Separation related problems

FOR AT HOME AND ON THE GO

D.A.P. Collar always stays with your
dog to help your dog cope with
new and fearful situations. Each
collar lasts up to 4 weeks

- Puppy socialization
